

# School Information

### Leaving Early

#### Late for School

Please endeavour to get your children into school as close to 8.20am as possible. It's very important that the children get to settle into class, prepare for the day ahead and catch up with their friends in the morning. Children who arrive after the 8.40 am bell must be signed in at the office.

#### Enrolment

#### Parent Teacher Meetings
